





Choose the date to be the last day of the year that you are budgeting through. In this example, we will choose 12/31/2019 since we are budgeting the year 2019.



Choose the Fixed Assets group you use for internal depreciation, your dataset may be called "Book." In this example we will choose the INTERNAL.





## Click on Projection.



Click on OK to proceed.



While the process is running, you will see a green progress bar at the bottom. It is not uncommon for the green bar to immediately jump to 95% and then apparently hang for a long time. Just be patient. It will complete the process.



Mhile the process runs, the projection button will be grayed out.



• The process is complete when the projection button becomes colorful again. Note: There is no pop-up message to tell you that it is complete.









The screen will default to the Depreciation Summary Tab. Select the year that you are budgeting from the FA Year dropdown list.












